GOAL

To encourage you to activate your faith in the midst of a crisis.

OVERVIEW

How to Manage a Crisis

- PRAYER: Prayer connects our <u>heart</u> to God's <u>ear</u>.
- WORD: The Word gives <u>activation</u> to our faith.
- FAITH: Faith comes by <u>hearing</u> God's word.
- TRUST: Trusting God, the one who <u>cures</u> and the one who <u>cares</u>.
- SHARING: Connecting your <u>hurt</u> with someone's <u>heart</u>.

Praying Through a Crisis

- It strengthens our bond with God.
- It softens our heart to receive from God.
- It's heard by God.

What is crisis mode?

• The state of high alertness and changed priorities that we use to manage extremely <u>challenging</u> and <u>threatening</u> situations.

Jesus' works testify of Him. (John 4:43-45)

What have you seen Jesus do that made you believe?

The Official departed with the Word in his heart. (John 4:46-50)

- How could the Official had responded when Jesus told him, "unless you see signs and wonders you won't believe"?
- How did he respond? Why?

The Word is working even when you don't see it. (John 4:51-54)

- How do you respond when all you have is His Word, but no evidence of what you prayed for?
- How does Luke 17:14 relate to this Official's situation as Jesus told him to depart?
