### **DIGGING IN | DISCOVERING WHAT GOD SAYS IN SCRIPTURE**

- 1. What does boastworthy generosity look like?
  - a. Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-5.
  - b. To what does Paul attribute the church's acts of generosity?
  - c. Read Philippians 2:6-8 and 2 Corinthians 8:9. How does Jesus exemplify and enable boastworthy generosity?

- d. Read through 2 Corinthians 9 together slowly. Along the way, stop and point out the things that make the church's generosity boastworthy.
- e. What would it look like for our church to participate in God's generosity like this?
- 2. Wait, the Bible says it's okay to brag?
  - a. Skim through 2 Corinthians 8-9. How many times does Paul brag about the generosity of the Macedonian church?
  - b. What about the attitude of the church itself? Is it braggy or humble about its own generosity?
  - c. What does this teach us about bragging and boasting?
  - d. What would it look like to call out and celebrate generosity in one another?
  - e. Talk about the most generous person or church you've ever known.
