Grace, Power & Wisdom: Learning to Use the Holy Spirit's Tools

- 1. In Acts 6:8-10, we see the effects of Stephen's connection with the Holy Spirit. Where does this connection come from? (See John 15:26-27 & John 16:12-13).
- 2. How can we grow in our own connection and reliance on the Holy Spirit? (See 2 Timothy 3:14-17 & Matthew 18:19-20).
- 3. When it comes to being a joyful witness, what are some of the things we tend to do rather than share and live the Good News with grace, power and wisdom from the Spirit?
- 4. Where are there opportunities for you to grow in grace, power and wisdom?

Living for Your Eulogy Rather Than Your Resume

- 1. Read through Stephen's last moments in Acts 7:51-60. What do you notice? Does anything he says remind you of someone? (See Mark 14:53-63, 15:34-37 & Luke 23:34).
- 2. Talk about the importance of your last words. What do Stephen's last words say about his character and mission?
- 3. How do you think Stephen's vision of Jesus is connected to his ability to forgive his enemies? As you think about people who are difficult to forgive, how might you follow his example?
- 4. What would it look like to live for your eulogy rather than your resume?
