## **DIGGING IN** DISCOVERING WHAT GOD SAYS IN SCRIPTURE

## When You're Pushed Out of Your Comfort Zone

- 1. In Acts 8:1-25, we see how God uses hard times to get His people out of their comfort zone and to carry out the mission (Acts 1:8).
- 2. Imagine what it would have been like to be a Jesus follower in Jerusalem. What are the financial, emotional and physical implications of Acts 8:1–3? (Compare with Acts 2:42–47).
- 3. Can you relate to hard things pushing you out of your comfort zone?
- 4. Read through Acts 8:4-25. How did God make what was meant for evil work out for the best? (Compare with Genesis 50:20).
- 5. How have you seen this work out in your life?

#### **Real Power**

- 1. In this passage, Simon gets a lesson on the source of real power. What are some lies he believes about fame, power and money?
- 2. How does Peter rebuke and correct Simon?
- 3. Look at Peter's response to Simon in Acts 8:20-23. What's wrong with Simon's view of power? How is the power of the Spirit different than the world's kind of power?
- 4. What does it look like today when people take the world's kind of power into the church?

# The Surprising Power of the Gospel

- 1. In this passage, the gospel's transforming power moves through Philip, a lay person, and catches even Peter and John off guard! Who would ever think that Samaritans and magicians could be saved?
- 2. What's the most surprising conversion you've ever seen?
- 3. How does that encourage you to share the gospel with the people around you at work or school?
