## How do we reach the nations? (cf Matthew 28:19-20 & Acts 1:8)

- 1. Seek God, the Lord of the Harvest-through Fasting and prayer
- 2. Send those the Lord is calling and support them in prayer and financially
- 3. Be clear about the message—ask God to confirm it through whatever He chooses
- 4. Prepare for opposition and see closed doors and opportunities to reach others
